THE 1984 RABBIT CONVERTIBLE. PROOF THAT GERMAN ENGINEERING CAN BE FUN.



At a time when most auto makers were turning away from the convertible, Volkswagen was turning thousands of drivers into open-air touring buffs. It's not surprising. Nothing is more exhibitanting than driving this Volkswagen with the top down.

But before you put the top down, examine it a bit closer. The top, like the body, is custom made and hand-fitted by the master craftsmen of the famous Karmann coachworks. Its three insulated layers eliminate both moisture and wind noise. As an added safety measure, a rear glass window equipped with an electric defroster, is fitted right into the top.

When the top is down, it's hidden securely in its boot. Another hidden feature of the Convertible is the structural reinforcement that went into the body to maximize its strength. All that's visible of these extraordinary protective measures is the sporty roll bar.

In addition to unlimited headroom, the Convertible offers a long list of standard features, including a fuelinjected, 1.8 liter engine, 5-speed close ratio transmission, sport suspension, ventilated front disc brakes, a 4-speaker electronic stereo cassette radio and the kind of performance that goes perfectly with the wind in your hair.

BODY, SUSPENSION BRAKES AND STEERING

Two and four-door hatchback, unitized construction with energy absorbing front and rear crush zones, four wheel independent suspension, coil spring/shock absorber struts front and rear, T-beam rear stabilizer axle, dual-diagonal hydraulic brake system with power-assist and rear brake pressure regulator, fist caliper disc brakes - front, rear drums (self-adjusting), rack and pinion steering.
